

From Our Pastor

Ever have a rotten day and you have “the tude” to go along with it? Are you consistently fighting a bad attitude? Your family sees it, your coworkers have to put up with it. It may even bother you, but it seems like you cannot shake it. Many times it is more of a heart issue than anything. Proverbs 23:7 says “For as he thinks in his heart, so is he.” Dale Robbins wrote in his book entitled, Check Your Attitude that “attitudes are inner dispositions of the heart and thoughts — they are the hidden intentions which will eventually serve as the basis for our actions.”

He went on to write, according to the Merriam Webster dictionary, “the word “attitude” means an internal position or feeling with regard to something else.” Airplane pilots often use “attitude” to describe their horizontal relationship with the runway when they land. If their attitude isn’t aligned properly, the plane will make contact with the ground at the wrong angle and it will cause them to crash.”

Man, doesn’t that sound an alarm? In other words if we don’t bring our attitudes into check with God then there is the potential of crashing and burning in life. Have you ever looked at it from that standpoint? The sad commentary is that we usually infect others with our attitudes, not just ourselves.

Chuck Swindoll wrote in an article entitled “Attitude”, “The longer I live, the more I realize the impact of ATTITUDES on life. Attitude, to me is more important than facts. It is more important than the past, than education, than money, than circumstances, than failures, than successes, than what other people think or say or do. It is more important than appearance, giftedness, or skill. It will make or break a company.... a church..... a home. The remarkable thing is we have a choice everyday regarding the Attitude we will embrace for that day. We cannot change our past we cannot change the fact that people will act a certain way. We cannot change the inevitable. The only thing we can do is play on the one string we have, and that is our attitude I am convinced that life is 10% what happens to me and 90% how I react to it.”

There definitely is a correlation between our heart and our attitude, but I think there are several issues that come in to play also. Sometimes there are physical issues that we are dealing with that maybe we are not even aware of. In some cases the best thing you need is a good physical to make sure that you are in good physical shape. There are also external pressures that cause so much stress that life just looks bad all the time. Identify those pressure points in your life and make the proper adjustments if possible.

How do we correct our attitudes? First of all, we must identify and repent of our bad attitudes. We must be willing to admit that we have a bad attitude. That is not always easy to do. The Bible says in Acts 8:22 “Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.” Secondly, commit your attitude to God. We must exercise discipline in our thought life and submit our thoughts to those of Christ’s. A good attitude is a matter of faith, disregarding your feelings, with a determination to embrace God’s outlook and disposition. Thirdly, cultivate and feed a good attitude. If all we focus on is the negative then how is that going to affect our attitude? “Remember garbage in, garbage out.” Paul wrote in Philippians 4:8, Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. We must focus on those things that cultivate a positive attitude. That is why it is so important to have a daily quiet time to have some good positive input. If we dwell on the negative all the time, then our attitude is going to reflect the same.

As Christians we should always reflect the true nature of Christ. Even amidst the challenges of life, we should show forth a Christ-like attitude. Through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, this is possible. We must make the conscious effort to allow the Holy Spirit to empower us. It is intentional. Our relationships depend on it!!

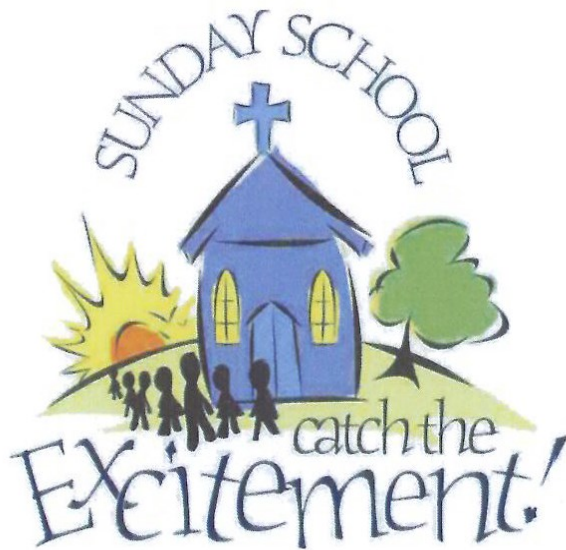


A Ladies Prayer Advance Reunion

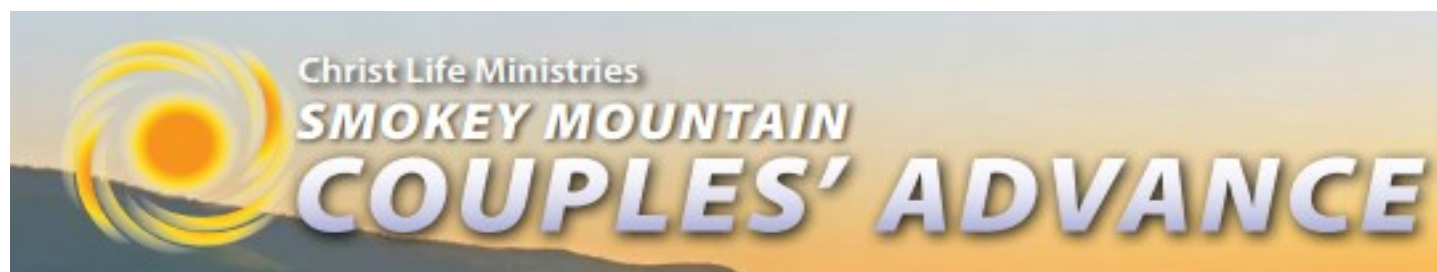

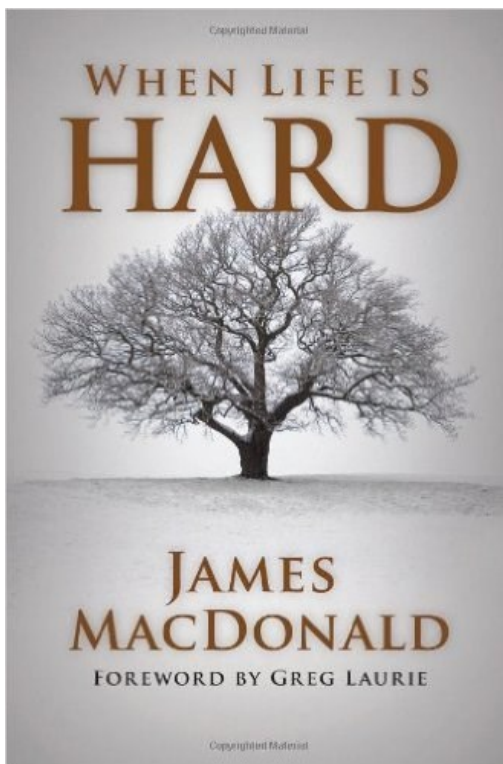
100 backpacks of school supplies will be distributed!

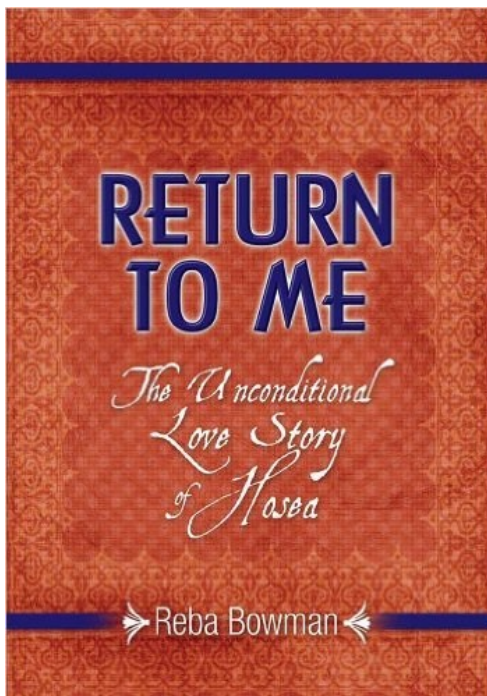

Last year we provided 30 backpacks full of supplies for children in need in our area. We hope that you will help us continue this important ministry this year!



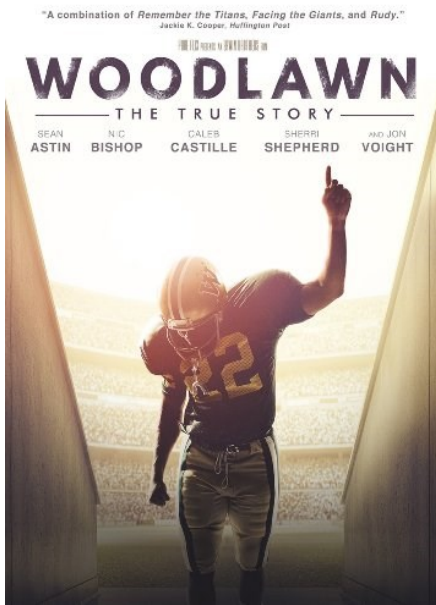

BUSY JULY!

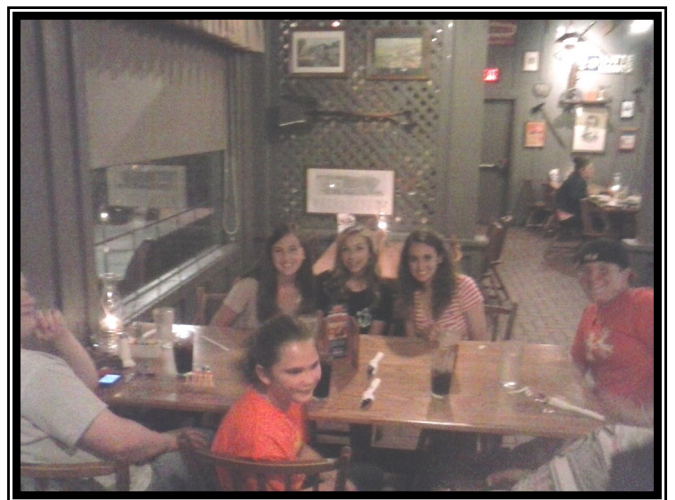

Student Prayer Advance

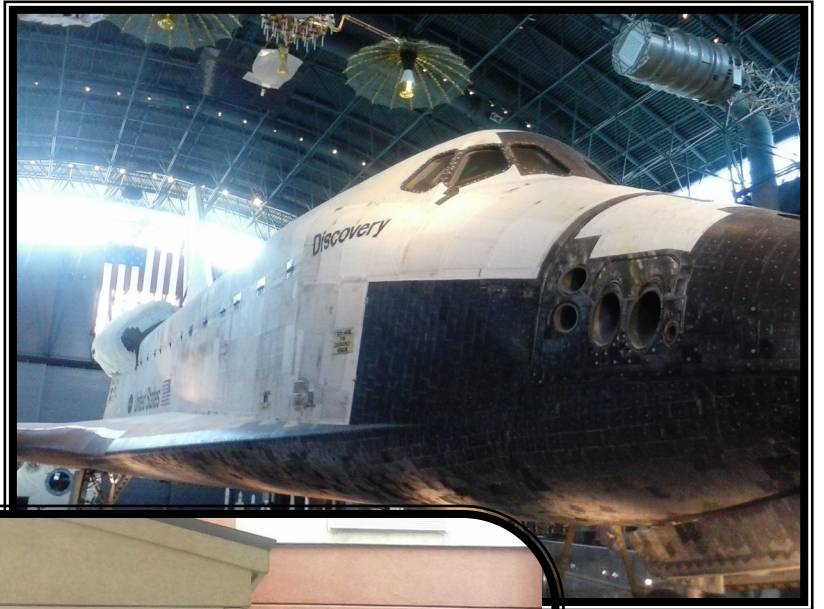

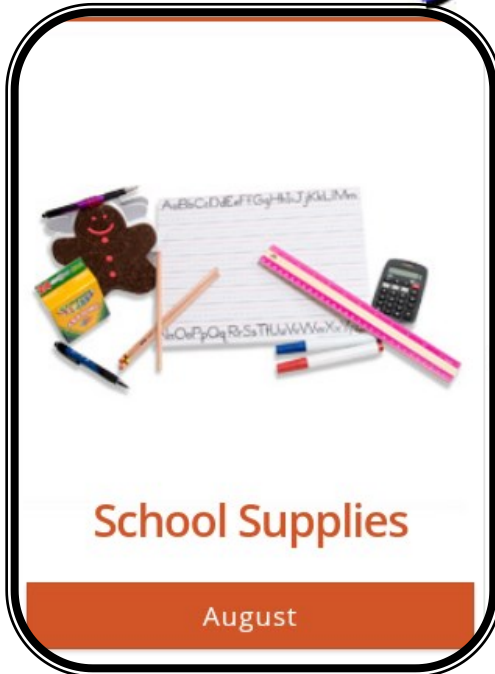
We thank our church family and the chaperones for investing in our youth so that they were able to attend the student prayer advance.
