From Our Pastor

We as a church have prayed over the years for God to enlarge our coast and to expand our horizon. Through this, we have come to understand that He is more than willing to do this than we could ever imagine. One of the beautiful aspects of His work is that He gives us an opportunity to have a part in seeing that accomplished. Embarking on a building program has to be a joint effort. There is no way that this project could be accomplished by just individual effort, or the participation of a few. It must be a collective effort. In Nehemiah chapter 2 the people of his day "rose up to build". They understood the saying "many hands make a light load." Nehemiah chapter 4 verse 6 says, "So built we the wall; for the people had a mind to work." We must pray and ask God to reveal to us what our part is in trusting Him to supply the need. I am a firm believer that God has the supply before we ever had the need.

On Sunday, February 5, we launched a Capital Giving Campaign to pay for our new multipurpose building by distributing pledge cards to our church body. Each person was asked to prayerfully consider a weekly, monthly or annual pledge. We recognize that more than likely, this building will be paid for by the faithfulness of God's people over a period of time. This Sunday is the cut-off date to turn those pledge cards back in. Understanding that God works through His people, would you please take some time to ask God what He would have you to give towards this project? Some people are in a financial position to write a large check, but most can do a smaller amount over a longer period of time. What would the Lord have you to do?

Another opportunity we have to enlarge our coast in the area of spiritual growth is to be a part of the new study that will start this Sunday evening. There are 7 motivational gifts spoken of in Romans chapter 12. Of those 7 gifts mentioned, what is the gift that helps to define you? Is it the gift of teaching? Do you have a natural gift in exhorting and motivating others to serve the Lord even when they don't want too? Are you prone to show mercy when the people around you are working through difficulties? Do you have a gift of organization or a gift of giving? Do you have a prophetic edge that is greatly needed within the work of God? Do you get fulfillment in serving others? Usually there is at least one primary gift that is intertwined and woven within the framework of your personality and character. There is also the evidence of other gifts that seem to surface from time to time. Surely God can bring any gift He wants to the surface to use at any given moment under many different circumstances. That is why it is extremely important that we know and understand how God has gifted His people.

Understanding the characteristics, uses and misuses of these motivational gifts will definitely help us in our service to the Lord and to others. Marriages have been helped as a result of a husband and wife coming to understand why their mates respond to different situations through the spiritual gift God has given them. For instance, how do parents view correction and discipline concerning their children?

Starting this Sunday, March 5, at 6:00 pm, we will be defining these 7 motivational gifts and giving a Biblical example of individuals that these gifts were given to. We will see how the 7 different gifts were used by God to accomplish His purposes. One of our major objectives for the class will be to help those that attend to come to a deeper understanding of how God has gifted them so that they can use that gifting to the fullest in His kingdom. Will you please take the time to avail yourself to this very important material?




EASTER OFFERING


