We are so Blessed and Thankful for God's Goodness n Blessings upon our ministry and our families. God has been good and always good even through trial's and hardships...

Praising the Lord that all seems to be getting better here. On Jan. 10 Rhonda had her complete hysterectomy surgery, all went well and she doing a lot better, still fatigued quite a bit, Doctor cleared her to resume normal activities but going through 2 major surgeries in a 9 month period takes quite a bit out of you...they wanted her to get back on the chemo pill but she took it for a week and caused her liver numbers to go high again so they took her back off them and think they gonna keep her off. We still have to go to Durango, CO weekly for a blood draw to check numbers and she has a checkup in 3 months.

We are looking forward to another of God's Blessing to us here, Brittany n Isaiah are expecting our 12 grandchild, there first by the end of this month. They are down 4 1/2 hrs. away in Socorro, NM where he is going to college at NM Tech, so we will be traveling down when she goes into labor.

An answered Prayer was we had a contractor come out with his plumber and quote a price for getting our gas line spliced back together and our house hooked back up for a more reasonable price. We have had 2 other quotes, one was \$18,000.00 and the other \$12,000.00. This contractor quoted us \$3000.00. Praising God for the quote and Thankful for those that are helping us with the price quote. So Thankful for God's children that want to help in a time of need. Just waiting on the weather to clear so they can come out and get started on work.

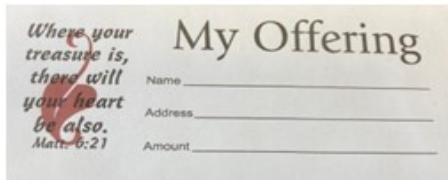


WAYS TO GIVE

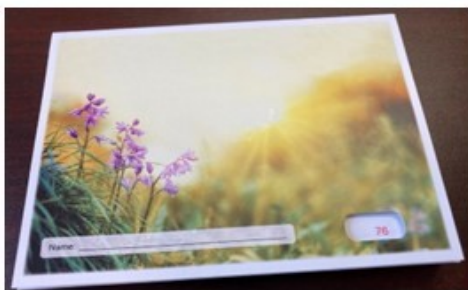
There are many ways for you to make financial contributions to our church!
