### From Our Pastor

To be a mother is one of the greatest responsibilities that God could bestow upon a woman. One mother wrote: "Being a mother is truly a remarkable gift and a privilege that I hold very close to my heart. To me, being a mother means to be fearless, to be a positive role model, to be a continuous cheerleader for every milestone my children will experience, to demonstrate the abundance of unconditional love that has no end and to cherish the countless memories that are truly priceless."

There are many mothers written about throughout the Bible. The one that we want to focus on today is Mary, the mother of Jesus. The Bible says that before and after Jesus was born that Mary pondered a lot of things in her heart. According to verses 19, 33 and 51 Mary kept things in her heart. The word ponder means, "to think or consider especially, quietly, soberly, and deeply." It means, "To treasure: to hold or keep as precious." Have you ever stopped to think of what Mary might have kept in her heart as a mother, especially being the mother of Jesus?

First of all, reflection would be at the forefront. How could she not rehearse all the things that happened to her leading up to the birth of Jesus? Can you imagine an angel appearing to you one night and telling you that you are going to birth into this world the Son of God? To think that God chose her out of all the women in the world to birth His son into the world would be something beyond comprehension.

Secondly, verification. The promises made to Mary about this baby were so big that they were hard to believe. You might say that they were easy to doubt, but God gave Mary reasons to believe and verified them in many different ways. Someone said, "Mary probably already had a baby book written before the baby was ever born." When Mary heard that she would bear the Messiah, surely, she spent so much time thinking about and pondering over all the promises in the Scriptures about the Christ, the Messiah. Every move God made was verification of His power and His love for mankind.

Thirdly, submission. Then came the night in Bethlehem when God stepped down out of heaven and came into this world as the babe of the manger. Everything He said came to fruition in that moment. All the things that she had heard and seen were verified in the coming of the babe of the manger. Mary's whole connection with these events began with a message from the angel. It must have been like a reminder of the love of God for Mary to know that God was at work fulfilling His promises and she was a main object of that fulfillment. As she walked in submission to God, He laid out His plan for the redemption of mankind.

Moms, think about the privilege God extends to you in being an instrument in His hands to miraculously birth babies into this world. As God uniquely forms and fashions these little ones and then turns around and uses you to bring them into this world. Every baby born is a verification of His great love for us and the ability that He has to give life.

I am so thankful for the mother that God gave to me. What a great lady she was and what an awesome mother she was. I have thanked God a million times over for allowing me the honor and privilege to have the mother that I did. I was truly blessed beyond measure by having a mother that taught me much about the nature of Christ. Little did I know what God was up to in giving me insight into His heart through her. God used my mother to show me much concerning His great love for others and the necessity of sacrificing for others.

Thank you, Lord, for the "remarkable gift and a privilege" that you have given to many ladies. Today we take this opportunity to rise up and call our Mothers, blessed!




