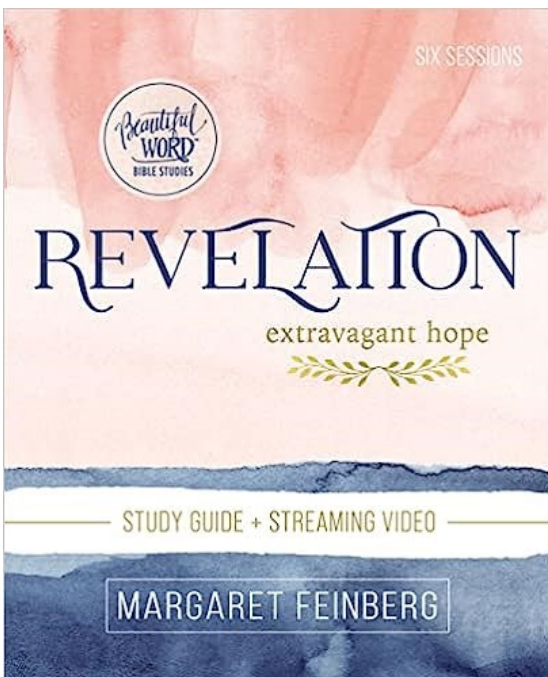

Revelation, while rich in prophecy, this often feared and underread book is also vibrant with the supreme greatness and authority of Jesus Christ. Praise is a central theme of this book.

#### AS YOU READ EACH DAY, ASK YOURSELF:

- **What scene does the verse paint?**
- **What are the names or titles of God and Jesus?**
- **What attributes are listed?**
- **How is Jesus described?**
- **What keywords are used?**
- **Are there any commands to obey?**

#### HOW TO USE THESE IN PRAYER:

- **Use the name to address God.**
- **Praise Him for what the attributes reveal about His character.**
- **Envision the scene in heaven.**
- **Thank God for the truth or promise found.**
- **Ask God to reveal any view that does not align with the verse.**
- **Pray the verse back to God.**
- **Ask God to help you worship Him as it is done in heaven.**
