From Our Pastor

Freedom? What is freedom? It is a word that you hear used a lot, especially this time of the year, but do we really understand the true meaning of it? I have learned over the years that if I don't really understand the true meaning of the word it could result in bondage and enslavement. A young man told me years ago that he wanted to be free from his parents bossing him around, so he was going to join the Marines. Yeah, right!! Wonder how that worked out for him???

From a Christian worldview, true freedom is not a matter of doing what you want without restraint but cultivating a life in obedience to God's will. In other words, freedom results when our wants align with God's will. Many times, when we choose to do whatever we want, it results in bondage or enslavement and that is not freedom. Freedom is the ability to choose to do the right thing.

God has told us in His Word that we are free to choose between good and evil. We may choose liberty and eternal life by following Jesus Christ. Freedom is not the ability to do whatever. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 6:12, "All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any." Basically, what Paul was saying here is, I have access to everything, but I am not going to allow myself to be brought into bondage of anything that is not good for me. He was exercising his freedom to choose to do the right thing and protect himself from potential danger.

God gives us the free choice and free will to live our lives the way we desire. That gift of freedom is the greatest gift that He can give. However, He wants us to choose to do right, because of our love for Him and that we want to obey Him, and to make our decisions within the overall blueprint of His will for our life. That results in true freedom.

In Judges 16, we are told the story of Samson. Samson was a mighty man that God was going to use greatly in setting His people free. But amidst all the decisions that Samson made, he created a lot of problems for himself. He had the freedom to make decisions for himself, but his problem was he always made bad decisions. And that does not bring us into freedom.

First of all, he defied his parents. He would not listen to anyone. You could not tell him anything. He saw a woman in Timnath and he told his parents that he wanted her. They tried to discourage him from entering into a relationship with her but he made his choice. He said in verse 3, "Get her for me; she pleases me."

Secondly, he disregarded his upbringing. God had a plan according to chapter 13:5. God was going to use him to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines. But Samson chose to throw it all away.

Thirdly, he defiled his purity. He had an attraction to sin, an ambition that was stubborn and an arrogance that was selfish. He chose to do what was best for him, he thought.

Fourthly, he denied God's promptings. He paid no attention to the will of God for his life. He was not willing to follow God's promptings at all.

What Samson thought was freedom in his decision making was really the opposite. He did not realize that choosing to do the wrong thing would take him further than he was willing to go, keep him longer than he was wanting to stay, and cost him more than he was willing to pay. In that "so called freedom" to choose to do whatever, Samson ended up in a blinding, binding, grinding, reminding bondage that he was never able to get free of. It is all found in verse 21 in chapter 16 of the book of Judges. It states, "But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house." Yes, God ended up using Samson in the end to a degree, but he never lived up to his greatest potential because he never came to understand the true meaning of freedom. Are you free today? Have you come to that place of understanding as to what true freedom is? It is not just a definition of a word but it is something that we can experience personally. Galatians 5:13 "For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty (freedom); only use not liberty (freedom) for an occasion to the flesh (to do evil), but by love serve one another. In the words of Peter Marshall, "May we think of freedom, not as the right to do as we please, but as the opportunity to do what is right."




