Dear Brothers and Sisters of Hollywood Baptist,

We thank the Lord for your prayers! We surely need your prayers and the Lord's wisdom. The Lord has been good to us. In July, our newest grandchild was born, Aurelia Fiel Ridge. We can't wait to see her. Matt and Kate will bring her here to Mexico to visit us later in the year.

Earlier this month, we spent a week with colleagues who are working among the Zoque people in Chiapas, Mexico. We had a good time helping with a VBS for children and sharing the Gospel with many adults in the afternoon and evening. We stayed in the home of a Zoque family. Please pray for Carlina and her daughter-in-law Dalia and their family. Many men in the community must work in other parts of the country to earn a living and are gone for very long periods of time. Pray also for Nerry and Maricela, both of their husbands have been away for several months. We were able to share the Good News with both young mothers.



Pray also for a Baptist church in Mexico City we have been helping. Last week we served in their VBS and next Sunday, I will be preaching there. The church meets in the home of Victor and Isabel. Pray they will be able to reach many in their community for Christ.

Some other prayer requests:

We will be traveling to Colombia in September to participate in a training event with other missionaries and Colombian believers.

We are currently helping colleagues in Brazil to develop and evangelistic Bible Storying project in Portuguese.

Pray for us as we are developing some Bible Storying resources in English and Spanish for a US based church that will be ministering in the mountains of Peru in the coming months.

Pray we would boldly declare the Good News of Jesus Christ.

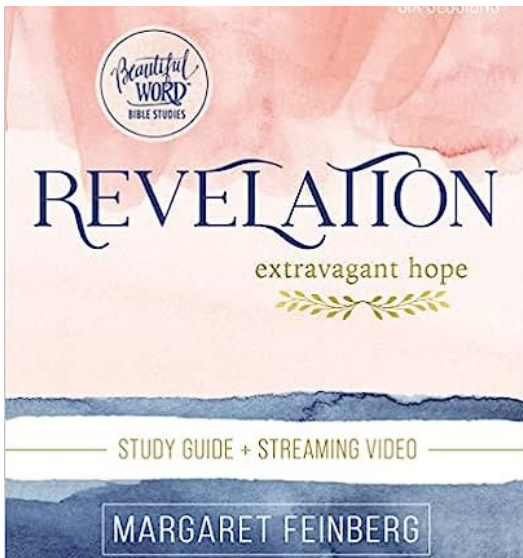
