Ike Murphey, was born 1975 in Graves County Kentucky. He grew up in a small town out side of Farmington, KY were he quickly fell in love with the great sport of hunting and fishing. As a kid hunting small game and bass was his everyday life style.

Ike started duck hunting in the fall of 1994 and quickly fell in love with the sport and the duck call itself. In 1999, Ike started making his own calls. He and his calls have won and placed in several hunting and meat-style calling contests. Although never winning his state contest in Kentucky, he has placed in the top four, four times in his competition career before ending his call making in 2017 to take a roll as pastor in his local church.

Ike also started hunting whitetail deer at the age of 10 with his dad and brother, killing his first buck at the age of 12, which scored in the 160s. In 2003, Ike killed the number 2 non-typical in the state of Kentucky that made the Boone and Crockett world record book at 199-2/8. Although never topping his 2003 season, Ike has taken several deer since scoring in the 120s-140s.

Today Ike, continues to hunt and travel hunting all over North America for waterfowl and big game. However his first priority is to continue and enhance his personal walk with Jesus Christ which started at the age of 7. He has two children , Ethan and Maggie who are second in his priority list, only to Jesus Christ. Ike continues to work at the Paducah Atomic plant as a pipe welder as he pastors Enon Baptist Church.

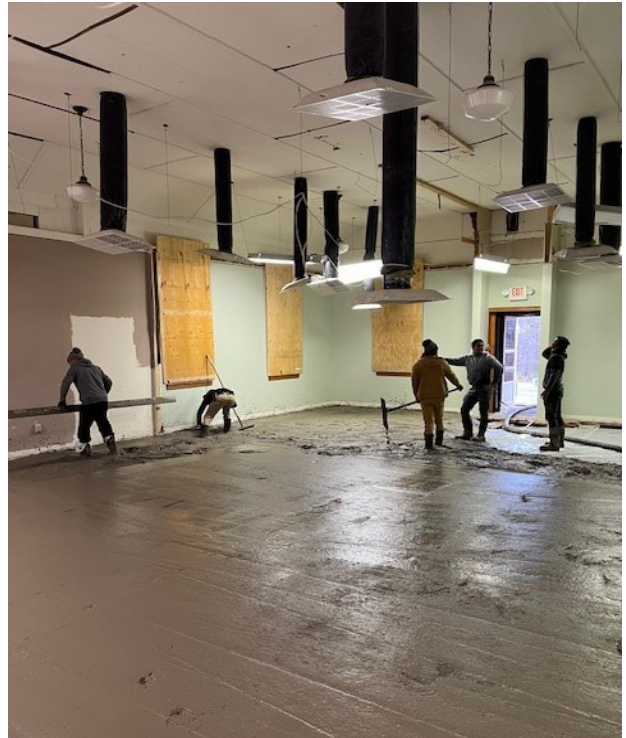
Pastor Terry & Hollywood Family,

Our children have been busy with the Hanging of the Greens and the Christmas play in the last part of the year.





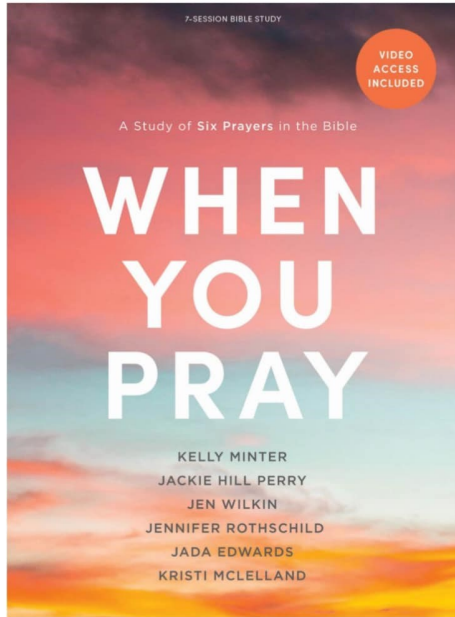
In Children's Church we are learning about creation. A big thank you to Pam Kendrick for updating our bulletin boards!
