#### From Our Pastor

God closes out the Old Testament with some very challenging words for fathers to consider. According to Malachi 4:6, "And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse." His desire is for us to make wise decisions so that we might be able to influence the hearts of our children in a positive way. I believe that we have to think through some of the main components that will help our kids feel more secure and have a deeper heart for God. Here are a few suggestions:

- 1. What is God's calling for our lives?
  - a. Love God Matt 22:37-38 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.
  - b. Love people Matt 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
  - c. Establish a "Life's Message." Building maturity in your life. Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
  - d. Build disciples Col 1:28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: Our life's goal should be to see our children walk with God and choose to live for Him.
- 2. How will we love our wives? Are we going to love them like we love pizza, hunting, fishing, and our dog and on and on the list goes. We are to love them
  - a. Faithfully
  - b. Unconditionally
  - c. Supremely
  - d. Sacrificially
- 3. What will our daily schedule look like?
- 4. How will we train our children?
  - a. Teach character. Teach our children to show respect for people and their property.
  - b. Biblical disciplines. Importance of devotional life. How to handle finances and the importance of tithing. How to handle our passions. The importance of prayer.
  - c. Develop skills in something our kids enjoy
- 5. How will we discipline your children? We must bring our child's heart under control. What form of punishment works with our child? Are you a screaming, yelling parent? Threatening and repeating parent?
  - Prov 23:13-14 Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die. Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.
  - Prov 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
- 6. What will your close friends be like? Prov 27:17 Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.
  - Do our friends motivate us to spiritual growth?
- 7. What will our source of income be?
- 8. How will we resolve conflicts in the home?
  Purpose not to go to sleep angry. Eph.4:27
  Learn to appreciate each other's point of view. Eph. 5:21
- 9. Where will church attendance fit into our list of priorities?
- 10. How will we care for your aging parents?

The greatest point of importance is influence. Determining to be a living example of what we desire to see in our children. God bless you men, and I want you to know that I am praying for you. May you say to your family, "follow me as I follow Christ."


