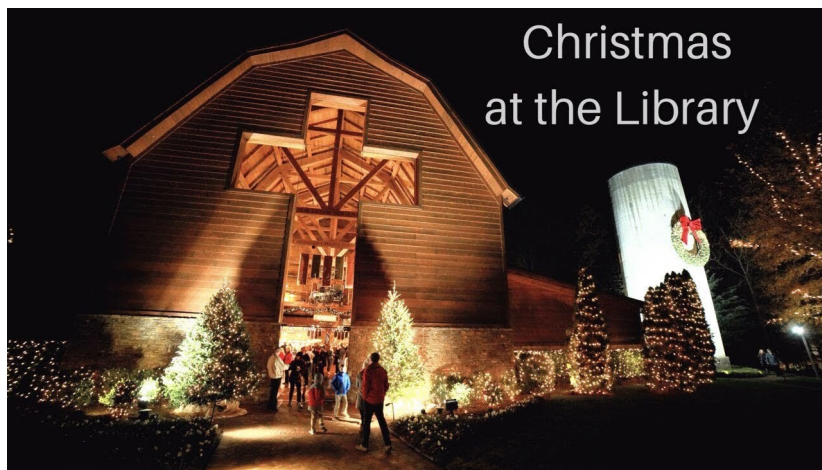

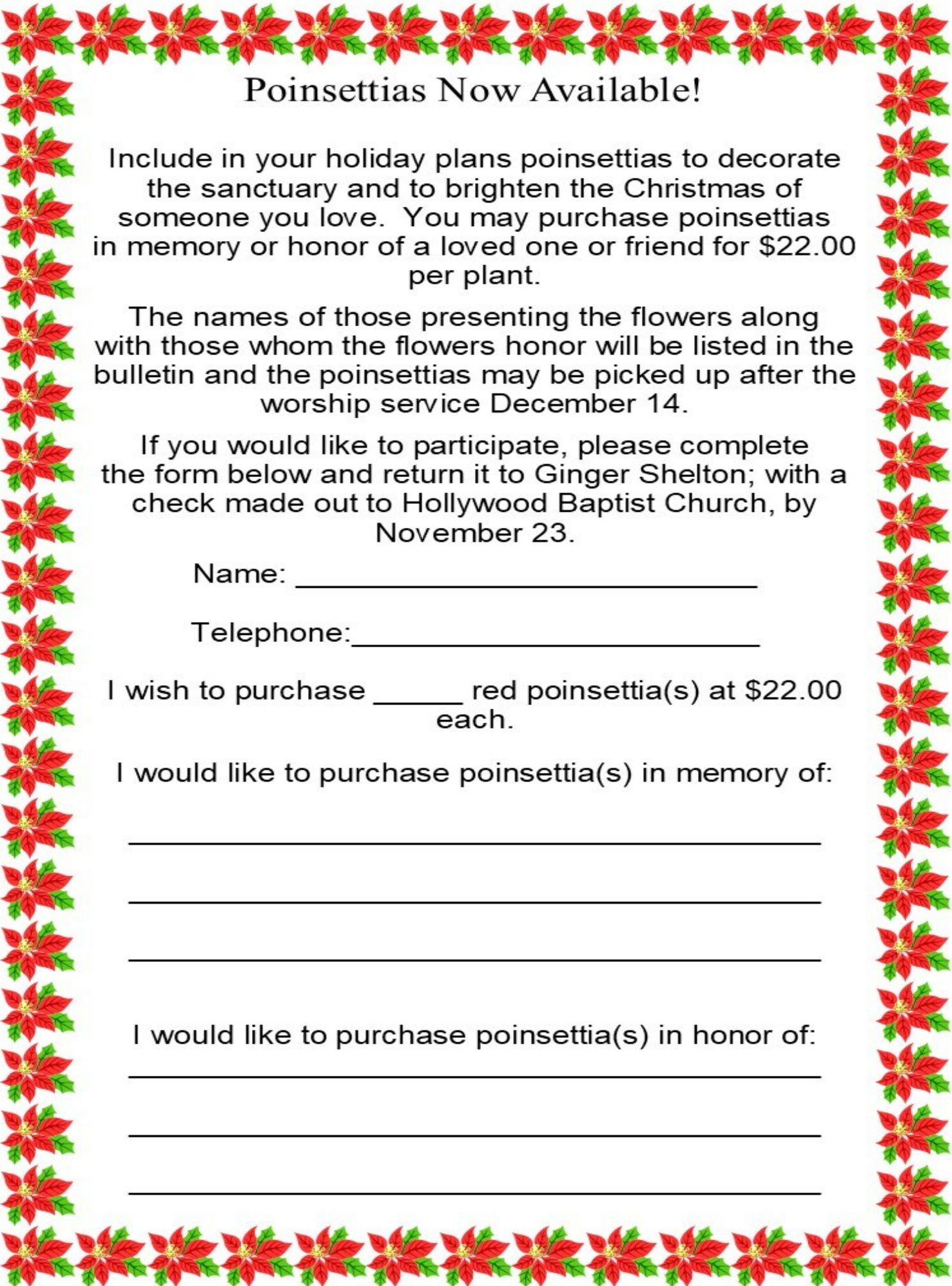


Hanging of the Greens
